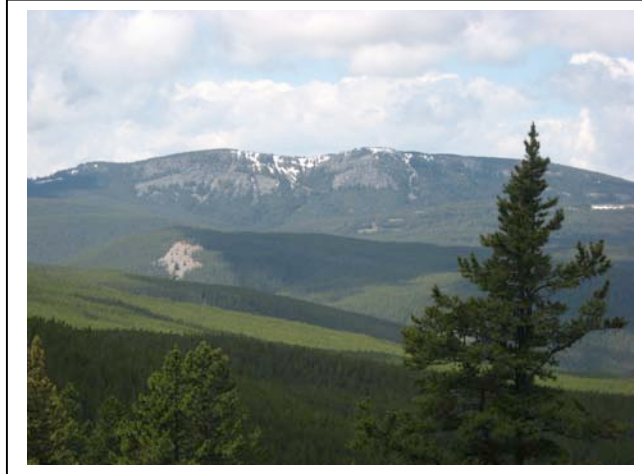


Montana High Divide Trails

Working Together



Cliff Mountain Crest Trail -- 15.5 miles

By linking quiet trails across three ranger districts-- mountain bikers, horseback riders runners and walkers will be able to follow the high divide along the forest border crowned by the Cliff Mountain "Crest" --from Kading Campground (Helena National Forest) to Thunderbolt Creek Trailhead (Beaverhead-Deerlodge National Forest)

When completed the Cliff Mountain Crest Trail will offer stunning views of the Flint Creek Range, Pintler Wilderness and Electric Peak Recommended Wilderness. It will also connect to quiet trails in Baggs Creek, Cottonwood Creek, Cottonwood Lake and the Continental Divide Scenic Trail, offering multiple backcountry trail options.

Portions of the trail need to be connected, restored and redesigned to meet lasting sustainable trail standards for foot, pack stock and bicycle travel.

Completion of the Cliff Mountain Crest Trail is a #1 priority of **Montana High Divide Trails**, nine organizations that have pledged to work together to recruit volunteers, raise funds to help the Pintler, Jefferson and Helena Ranger Districts connect and improve this exciting new crest trail.
